#### **AUTHORITY TO TRANSFER**

#### Utah State Code Section 10-6-135.5

"...a city may transfer money in an enterprise fund to another fund to pay for a good, service, project, venture, or other purpose that is not directly related to the goods or services provided by the enterprise for which the enterprise fund was created."



## NOTICING REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Provide notice of the intended transfer
- 2. Clearly identify the transfer in the budget
- 3. Provide notice of an enterprise fund hearing
- 4. Hold a public hearing

#### **PUBLIC HEARING REQUIREMENTS**

- Hearing must be separate and independent
- 2. Explain the intended transfer
- 3. Provide enterprise fund accounting data to the public
- 4. Allow comment

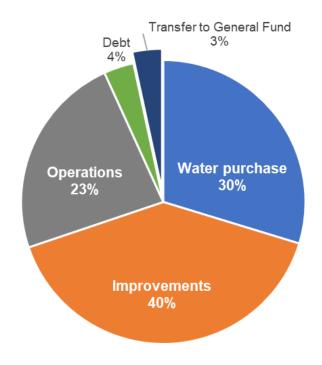

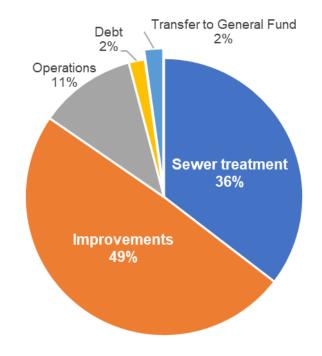

#### FY 2023 Sewer Fund Expense Budget

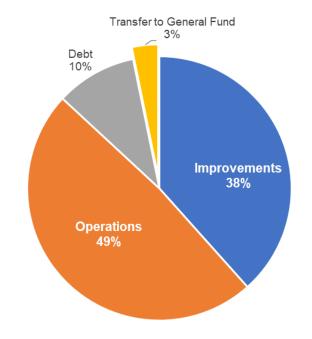
